Resolution on the Russian Invasion of Ukraine

WHEREAS the Russian Federation on the 24th of February 2022, in violation of international law, expanded its war against Ukraine by launching an unprovoked and unjustified invasion of Ukraine; and

WHEREAS the Russian military has attacked and seized multiple nuclear facilities putting Ukrainians, Russians, and Europeans at risk of a nuclear incident. The Russian military has also been holding facility workers hostage; and

WHEREAS the Russian Federation is in violation of international law including the UN charter; and

WHEREAS the impact to the rules-based international order, global security, and the credibility of future international agreements like the Budapest Memorandum have been put in jeopardy; and

WHEREAS the Russian Federation has made repeated threats to many countries including of a nuclear nature; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Young Democrats of America denounces and condemns to the strongest possible degree the actions of the Russian Federation against Ukraine and its citizens and we call on the Russian Federation to immediately end its invasion and withdraw its troops from Ukrainian territory; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Young Democrats of America condemns the Belarussian government for its participation and calls on the Belarussian government to immediately stop assisting the Russian Federation in this war and remove Russian troops from their territory; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Young Democrats of America affirms its solidarity with the people of Ukraine; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Young Democrats of America calls on the international community to do everything it can to assist the refugees fleeing Ukraine; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Young Democrats of America expresses its full support for the rules based international order and believes that the borders of nations should not be able to be changed by military force; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Young Democrats of America calls on the Russian Federation to immediately stop its attacks on nuclear facilities and to immediately leave unimpeded the workers of nuclear facilities so they can do their jobs safely and effectively; and
